Below is an update on school topics related to COVID-19:

- Our Junior/Senior High School pivoted to remote instruction today, Monday, February 1st. We made this decision in order to allow time for contact tracing related to a student who tested positive for COVID-19. The student who tested positive will return to school after their official Isolation Period has ended. A total of 19 students and 5 members of our JSHS were placed in quarantine as a result of this contact tracing process.
- At this time we are planning for our Junior/Senior High School to return to in-person instruction on Tuesday, February 2nd.
- On Tuesday, February 2nd officials from Onondaga County will be at our schools to conduct coronavirus testing on approximately 200 members of our school community. This group includes students, faculty, and staff at both the Elementary School and the Junior Senior High School.
