Dear Parents/Guardians,

Below is an update related to the possibility of offering a full-time in-person learning option for all of our PreK-12 students:

- All parents/guardians received a link to a survey earlier today. We ask that all parents/guardians complete this survey, even if you do not want to change your child's educational program.
- In this survey, parents will be able to choose between full-time in-person learning and full-time remote learning. Additionally, we are asking parents to choose between school provided transportation and transportation provided by another means of getting to and from school.
- Parent/guardians who have trouble completing this survey, or who did not get the survey link, should call the Tully Elementary School office (315-696-6213) or the Tully Junior/Senior High School office (315-696-6235).
- We are anticipating that our in-person enrollment will increase. If this happens, some student desks will need to be placed closer than six feet apart. Clear barriers will be used on desks that are placed closer than six feet apart.
- Program changes are contingent upon our ability to provide transportation given current social distancing requirements, and upon our ability to procure appropriate barriers, which will be needed for areas where students are seated less than 6 feet apart.
- Public health measures utilized during the 2020-21 school year will remain in effect. These public health measures include wearing masks, ongoing cleaning, social distancing, hand washing, asymptomatic COVID testing, and utilization of health screenings.

Let's all continue to work together to stay healthy so that we can expand in-person learning opportunities for our students.
