Below is an update related to the possibility of offering a full-time in-person learning option for all of our PreK-12 students:

Given this document, and given current Onondaga County Health Department quarantine guidelines, we believe it is possible to offer all of our PreK-12 students a full-time in-person learning option during this school year.
- In addition to this PreK-12 full-time in-person option, we will continue to offer a full-time virtual learning option for our PreK-12 students.
- In order to offer all of our PreK-12 students a full-time in-person learning option, we must amend the current *Tully CSD 2020-21 Reopening Plan*. We have already begun the process of doing so. We anticipate presenting an amended plan to the Tully Board of Education for consideration and acceptance on March 22nd.

- Prior to March 22nd, our ad hoc Reopening Steering Committee will be reviewing proposed amendments to the *Tully CSD 2020-21 Reopening Plan*.
- All proposed amendments to the *Tully CSD 2020-21 Reopening Plan* will follow guidelines set forth by the Onondaga County Health Department.
- We have two primary goals in crafting amendments to this plan. One goal is to expand in-person learning opportunities for our students. The other goal is to do all that is reasonably possible to keep all members of the Tully School Community healthy.

Let's all continue to work together to stay healthy so that we can expand in-person learning opportunities for our students.
