In order to be ready for this adventure, you will need to be prepared with the following items *when school starts*:

- Two - 1-subject spiral notebooks
- One - 1.5" plastic binder (NO zippers or Trapper Keepers)
- *Note: The binder will serve as a portfolio. Do *not* set up at home. Thank you!
- One - pack of 5 binder divider tabs
- One - heavy-duty, plastic two-pocket folder
- One - pair of scissors
- One - cloth, zippered pencil pouch to carry supplies
- One - handheld pencil sharpener (container type to hold shavings)
- One - pair of plug-in headphones/earbuds (*Reasonably sized*)

*Note: Students must have, carry and keep at school.

We encourage you to bring a **water bottle** & small **snack** each day.

Store bought birthday treats (due to food allergies) are always welcome. If a **birthday** falls on a **weekend** or **over a break**, please check in with the **homeroom teacher**.
