the forty fourth session eighteen fiftieths of  
the Gospel and School fund of the town of  
Tully in the County of Onondaga were granted  
to the town of Spafford in said County  
and Whereas the trustees of the town of Tully  
insist that the town of Spafford is entitled to  
sixteen fiftieths only of the said fund  
and whereas the said Trustees of Tully agree  
to petition the legislature at the next session  
thereof for relief in the premises -

Now therefore We the trustees of the town  
of Tully in said County do agree, in case  
the legislature shall not grant the relief  
sought by said trustees, and by these presents  
do bind ourselves and our Successors in office  
to pay to the trustees of the town of Spafford  
the sum of one hundred and seven dollars  
and seventeen cents and the interest thereon  
from the time which they became entitled  
to the said sum according to the aforesaid  
act, it being the balance due the said trustees  
of Spafford according to the aforesaid act  
the witness whereof we have hereunto set  
our hands and the seal of the Corporation  
the nineteenth day of September in the year  
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
twenty two - - -
